Academic Senate updates

Meeting was taken up primarily by the police and safety issues, & board policy updates

Item 3

Simple Syllabus updates

Amv. Helen

Amy presented info and discussion regarding the College Agreements and College Support for Students: in order to be able to push out updates to those sections of the syllabus, we will need to turn off edit capabilities for faculty. Once a faculty makes an edit, however small, to one of those sections, then Simple Syllabus will not automatically push out any updates. To push out updates (such as our new Al policy, or any revisions to contact info or links) Simple would need to lock those sections to faculty edits.

Bita, Dolores, want to edit

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Kas, wants to clarify if making them editable would open them up to faculty changing them

Brian E – can we lock the policy part and add a custom component that faculty can add? Yes.

Allison - If a faculty edits, then wants to go back to boilerplate to get edits pushed out, how do they do that? Answer – they would ask OL (Helen) and it would override their edited version.

Two options: have it locked down completely, or let faculty edit it so you won't get updates. 3rd choice – Add in an additional component that is editable.

How often will we revisit this and look at updates?

Helen is doing the student services update piece, reaching out to individual stakeholders, twice a year: mid/late Winter and in late Spring for Fall.

Recap: We're going to add an additional optional component for faculty to add additional info. In the meantime we're going to keep policies and services blocks locked down. And we're going to revisit Simple Syllabus twice a year. Until further discussion.

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Oli - I would like "Unique ways to use Canvas" - from making tabs to gamification of quizzes to hidden gems of Citilabs.

On-campus idea - "fun unknown technology equipment and rooms"

Helen - Can we do a raffle? "Run your Accessibility Dashboard checker and possibly win a prize!"

Lene – we are currently not allowed to run accessibility reports on courses, only faculty can run reports on their courses.
