

## AA in Art History

Earn your Associate in Arts degree online with a major in **Art History** at Foothill College.

### Associate Degree Requirements:

**Units required for Major:** 48

**English proficiency:** ENGL 1A, 1AH, 1S & 1T, ESLL 26 or equivalent.

**Mathematics proficiency:** MATH 17, 105, 108 or equivalent.

A minimum of 90 units is required to include:

- Completion of one of the following general education patterns:
  - Foothill General Education,
  - CSU General Education Breadth Requirements or
  - the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC)
- Core courses (36 units)
- Support courses (12 units)

\*Additional elective course work may be necessary to meet the 90-unit minimum requirement for the associate degree.

**NOTE:** All courses pertaining to the major must be taken for a letter grade. In addition, a grade of "C" or better is required for all core and support courses used for the degree.

The **courses listed BELOW are generally offered as online courses** at least once every two years. Please see Schedule of Classes for verification.

**NOTE:** One to two years of French, Spanish, Italian, or German is strongly recommended for students intending to continue in Art History at a 4-year institution. Students who wish to specialize in Asian Art should consider one or two years of Japanese or Mandarin.

  - or ART 2AH Honors History of Art: History of Western Art from Prehistory through Early Christianity (4.5 units)
- ART 2B History of Western Art from the Middle Ages to the Renaissance (4.5 units)
- or ART 2BH Honors History of Western Art from the Middle Ages to the Renaissance (4.5 units)
- ART 2C History of Western Art from the Baroque to Modernism (4.5 units)
- ART 2E A History of Women in Art (4.5 units)
- ART 2F Introduction to Asian Art (4.5 units)
- ART 2J American Art (4.5 units)
- ART 3 History of Modern Art from Post-Impressionism to the Present (4.5 units)

\* Recommended before taking Art History courses if no previous experience in art.
