

SUBJECT: Counseling Academic Year 15-16 SARS Memo

This report provides preliminary findings regarding the demographics and enrollment profiles of 2015-2016 students who made counseling appointments via SARS from Summer 2015 to Spring 2016. The data for this report is current as of November 8, 2016. SARS is an online appointment and scheduling system.

Student Profile of SARS 2015-16

- There are 8583 students who had appointments with the SARS system from Summer 2015 to Spring 2016.
- **Gender:** 55% of the student were female and 44% were male.
- **Age:** 65% of the students were under 24 years old, 29% of them were 25-39, and 6% of them were 40 or above.
- Ethnicity: Latino (26%) and White (26%) students make up the majority (52%), followed by Asian (25%) students. The ethnicity makes up is similar to the Foothill student population (less than 5% differences).



Student Educational Plan: 79% of the SARS students completed a student educational plan. **Financial Aid Award Type:** 61% of the SARS students did not have any financial aid, 28% of them received non-Pell Grant, and 11% of them received Pell Grant.

Student Type in Fall 2015

Among the total enrolled students (4,787) in Fall 2015, most students are continuing students (58%), followed by first-time transfer students (16%) and first-time students (14%).
