SUBJECT: Foothill Program Award Type Degree Memo from 2014-2016

This memo provides the comparison of program award types at Foothill College from 2014-2016, as shown in Table 1. All associate degrees include Associate of Arts (A.A.) and Associate of Science (A.S.). All ADT degrees include Associate in Science for Transfer (A.S.-T) and Associate in Arts for Transfer (A.A.-T). All certificates include certificates requiring more than 60 units, a range of 30-60 units, a range of 18-30 units and a range of 12-18 units.

Based on the results of Table 1, key observations as shown below:

- 1. There is significant growth of associate degrees for transfer.
- 2. For ADT degrees, there is a 12% increase when comparing to 2014-15 with 2015-16.
- 3. For Associate degrees, there is a 5% decrease when comparing to 2014-15 with 2015-16.
- 4. For Certificates, there is a 7% decrease when comparing to 2014-15 with 2015-16.
