## Foothill College Assessment Re-Test Analysis

March 21, 2017

## Summary of Observations - Based on Analysis by Angel Tzeng

- Out of approximately 3,200 individuals testing in 1 or more subjects from July 1 to December 31 2016, about 300 re-tested (about 9\%), with re-test rates varying from 6\% in English to 15\% on ESL (see Figure 1 below).
- F1 visa holders made up $55 \%$ of all re-test takers over the period.
- Overall, $59 \%$ of the re-test scores were higher than the initial assessment results; $32 \%$ were the same score; and $9 \%$ were lower than the initial assessment results.
- Most students re-tested within in a few weeks of the initial test - with $75 \%$ retesting in August and September.
- Course success rates in fall 2016 for students that re-tested were similar to the average for the enrolled courses in math, English, ESL.
