California General Education Transfer Curriculum (Cal-GETC)

Effective Fall 2025 through Summer 2026

Completion of Cal-GETC will allow students to transfer to either a UC or CSU without the need, after transfer, to take additional lower-division general education. Exceptions apply see a counselor to verify that the campus/major accepts Cal-GETC. Courses must be completed with a grade of "C" (C- is not acceptable). Grades of "credit" or "pass" are acceptable providing the grade designation is equivalent to a grade of C or higher. Students must request certification at time of transfer. Courses listed in two areas may be only applied to one.

U.S. History, Constitution and American Ideals (not required for Cal-GETC certification) is a CSU graduation requirement which may be used to satisfy Area 4. This requirement may be fulfilled by completing 2 courses: POLS C1000 and one U.S. History course from HIST 17A, 17B, or 17C. It is recommended that CSU students complete this requirement prior to transfer.

LANGUAGE OTHER THAN ENGLISH (not required for Cal-GETC certification) is a UC graduation requirement which may be satisfied at Foothill College. Students must demonstrate proficiency equivalent to two years of high school study in the same language with a grade of C or better or completion of one of the following courses:
