Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) 2022-2023 Academic Year

Completion of IGETC will allow students to transfer to either a UC or CSU without the need, after transfer, to take additional lower-division general education. Exceptions apply see a counselor to verify that the campus/major accepts IGETC. Courses must be completed with a grade of "C" (C- is not acceptable). Grades of "credit" or "pass" are acceptable providing the grade designation is equivalent to a grade of C or higher. Students must request certification at time of transfer. Courses listed in two areas may be only applied to one.
