- ❖ Addition to Course Family: CCC approved the following addition to an existing course family in Fine Arts and Communication, effective 2021-22:

- \* Ad Hoc Group: At the May 4th meeting, CCC approved the Proposal to Create New Ad Hoc Committee: Instructional Program Creation Process. The proposal has been posted on the CCC Policies & Resolutions webpage. - ❖ Guided Pathways Mapping Approval Process: At the May 4th meeting, CCC continued discussion about determining the best process for formal approval of Program Maps. The group discussed the challenges involved with cross-disciplinary programs, concerns about class scheduling as it relates to Maps for all programs, and the need to determine an ongoing process for annual review/updating of Maps. We hope to make a formal decision at CCC soon—if you would like to share your own thoughts about this process, please reach out to your CCC Reps.
- Program Mapper Software Demo: Also on May 4th, CCC welcomed a quest speaker—Natalie Latteri, Humanities faculty and co-lead of the Guided Pathways Meta Majors/Program Mapping team. Natalie provided a presentation of the Program Mapper software, which Foothill is considering adopting as the tool for students to use to view Program Maps and related information, and fielded questions from the group.
