- ❖ **CCC Priorities for 2021-22:** The main topic of conversation at CCC's November 2nd meeting was a list of priorities for the committee, drafted by Academic Senate leadership. The list includes: creating two primers on faculty primacy in curriculum, one for faculty and one for students; determining a process for ongoing updates and review of Guided Pathways Program Maps; creating new processes for program creation and discontinuance; drafting a CCC Equity Action Plan; and drafting CCC By-laws. Most of the conversation was spent on the first two items, and over the next few meetings we will continue to discuss each item on the list, in depth, and determine how to move forward.
