  - TOP Code: 1260.00 Health Professions, Transfer Core Curriculum Studies that satisfy the academic transfer requirements of the core curriculum for health professions.

- SAM Code: D (Possibly Occupational taken by students in the beginning stages of their occupational programs; can also be used for service (or survey) courses for other occupational programs [this is the code we assign to most vocational courses, outside of Allied Health)
- 5. APPROVED: HORT: 9 new course proposals: These are non-credit versions of the industry training courses. 400 series are the pesticide certifications and the 401 series are the landscape contracting series (parallel courses to the proposed HORT 80 E-J)
- 6. APPROVED: D A 100: Law and Ethics for the Dental Assistant: This is a new course for the Dental Assisting program
- 7. APPROVED: Paramedic Program Sheet Change: Dave would like to add AHS 60C to the First Quarter, and AHS 60D & 60F to the Third Quarter. Doing so would bring the total units for the degree to 76.5 (from 70.5)
