Dear EOPS Participants,

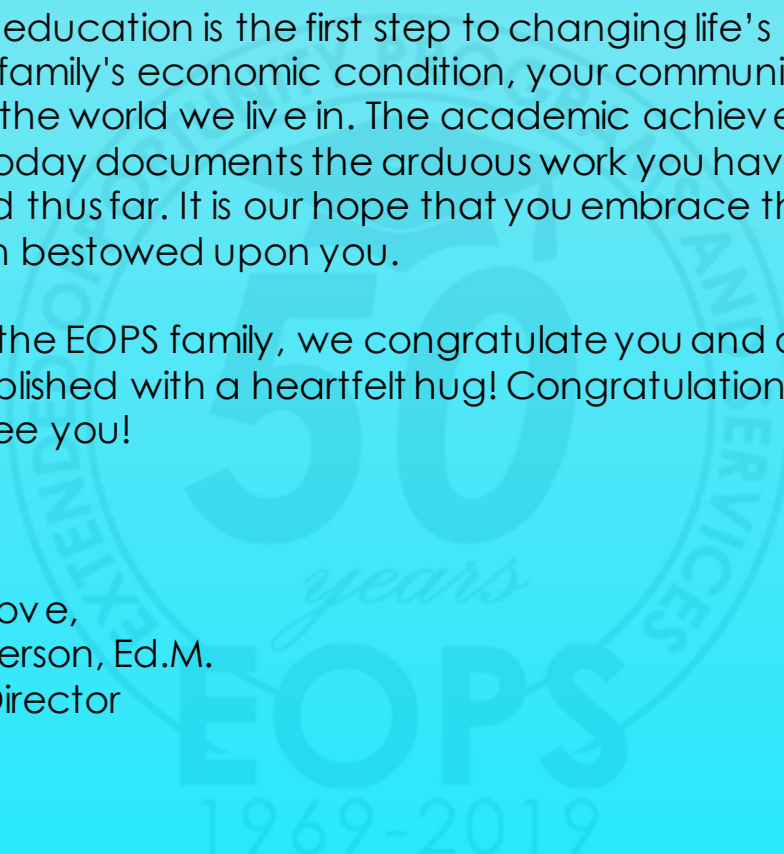
