# IEC's Role

- Gather feedback on the effectiveness of the governance structures, focusing on participation, understanding, and interaction

# ACCJC Standards 2024

- Roles, responsibilities, and authority for decision-making are clearly defined and communicated throughout the institutions. The institution's structure for decision-making provides opportunities for stakeholder participation and ensures the inclusion of relevant perspectives. (Standard 4.2)

- Survey to all employees and students
- Interviews with past and current participants

# IEC Recommendations – Mar 25<sup>th</sup>

- Conduct a formative evaluation in Spring 2025
- Identify content using May 2021 evaluation
- Return to MIPC on May 2<sup>nd</sup> to continue discussion
