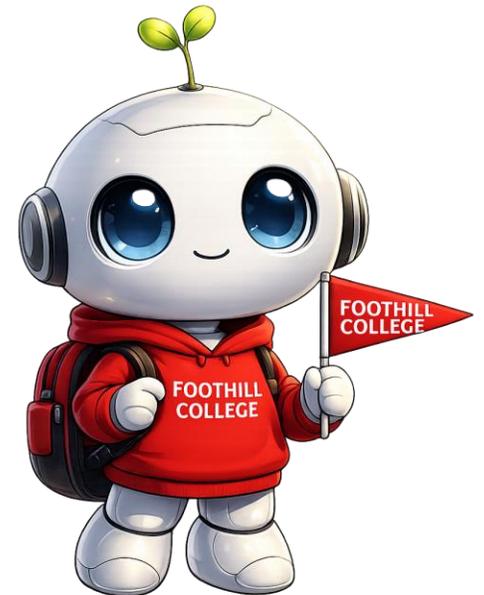
All AI Fellows First Meeting: 1/7/26
