Governance Handbook Charge

The charge of the Revenue & Resources Committee is to monitor goals related to the Educational Master Plan, as well as supporting plans, including the strategic allocation of resources to achieve plan goals, for the topic areas listed.

Proposed Charge

The Revenue & Resources Committee is a governance group whose primary function is to facilitate the strategic allocation of resources to support the College's efforts to reach the goals identified in its planning documents. The committee is charged with the following:

- (1) Establishing processes and implementing them for resource allocation and prioritization;
- (2) Reviewing institutional priorities related to resource allocation and planning (Facilities/Technology/Sustainability Plans);
- (3) Identifying and supporting policies related to the Educational Master Plan's Resources goals;
- (4) Investigating and recommending opportunities to increase revenue; and
- (5) Promoting advocacy related to resources management.
