# Vision Aligned Reporting is...

- Collecting and reporting data that directly aligns to student outcomes based on program-level activities



## Vision-Aligned Reporting to Support Student Success

Chancellor's Office Program Staff

Accurate data is critical to measuring our impact and ensuring we're working toward equitable, student-centered design and decision-making. For the past three years, the Chancellor's Office has been designing, piloting and refining Vision-Aligned Reporting. Starting in fall 2024, we are rolling out the first iteration of Vision-Aligned Reporting systemwide. Through this new program reporting process, colleges will report only information that offers direct visibility into how their efforts impact student outcomes.

We're aligning our reporting to focus on critical outcomes identified in our *Vision 2030*, which expands and builds upon the *Vision for Success* and the *Governor's Roadmap*. This will help us improve student outcomes, including making equity gains, increasing degree and certificate attainment, increasing transfers to four-year institutions, reducing students' excess unit accumulation and securing gainful employment.

### Systemwide New Reporting Process

Vision-Aligned Reporting will support colleges to collect and report data that directly aligns to student outcomes. We are pursuing an approach that will:

- Maximize colleges' time and resources.
- Enable institutions to evaluate, learn and evolve to better support student success.
- Make it easier for decision-makers to interpret and act on data from our institutions.

Based on what we learned during the pilot process, we are implementing the reporting process systemwide in fall 2024 across 11 college programs: **CAPYES-NextUP** (Formerly Cooperating Agencies for Foster Youth Educational Support), **CalWORKS**, **CCAP** (College and Career Access Pathways), **Dual Enrollment**, **DSPP** (Disabled Student Programs and Services), **EOPS** (Extended Opportunity Programs and Services) & **CARE** (Cooperating Agencies Resources for Education), **MCHS** (Middle College High School), **MESA** (Mathematics, Engineering, Science Achievement), **SEA** (Student Equity and Achievement) Program, **Strong Workforce**, **Local Share**, **Transfer Center Annual Report** and **Veterans Resource Centers**. # Vision Aligned Reporting and Vision 2030

- State Chancellor's Office identified goals to become more student-centered and equity-minded, streamlining policies, processes, and funding
- 2017: Vision for Success
- 2022: Governor's Roadmap
- 2023: Vision 2030

# Vision Aligned Reporting Purpose

- For system
  - Align the Vision 2030 goals to college programs and activities
  - Make it easier to share, interpret, discuss, and act on data from the 116 colleges
- For college
  - Facilitate institutional ability to evaluate, learn, plan, and evolve to better support student success
  - Promote cross-campus, cross-silo strategies for aligning and leveraging activities, programs, and funds
  - Integrate with MIS reporting and replace reporting requirements for most programs

  - Cross-program conversations and Vision 2030 goal-specific narratives

# Vision Aligned Reporting Program Data

- Year 1: 2024-25
  - Aggregated student-level activity data
- Year 2: 2025-26
  - CWIDs of each student served by program activities
- Disaggregated by Black/African American, Hispanic/Latina/o/e, and economically disadvantaged

# Vision Aligned Reporting Program Students

- Students served defined as those who take part in the activities, and not that the activity was simply made available to them.

# Vision Aligned Reporting Budget Data

- Programs to report all funding utilized
  - Total state allocation
  - Activity level totals by org codes
- District to provide actuals at end of August

# Are program outcomes tied to future funding?

- No. The purpose of the new process is to provide data that allows the Chancellor's Office and colleges to (1) more easily identify the impact of program activities on student progress and outcomes and (2) continuously improve programs and services to ensure equitable student support and success.

### About the Pilot

#### The Vision for Success

Guided by the Vision for Success, California Community Colleges are relentlessly focused on designing our institutions to respond to students' needs and support their goals. Equitable, student-centered design and decision-making is only possible when we have the information we need to understand our impact, make adjustments, and continually strive to support student success. That's why over the last three years, the Chancellor's Office has been designing, piloting and refining a new program reporting process for colleges that focuses on collecting only information that offers direct visibility into how colleges' efforts impact student outcomes. Based on what we learned during the pilot process, the system will implement the first iteration of the new reporting process and this online tool in fall 2024. Training and onboarding will be provided to colleges during the 2023-2024 academic year to prepare for implementation.

#### The Process and Tool

The Vision-Aligned Reporting Project process is a comprehensive reporting structure that aims to support colleges by:

- Improving capacity to plan, budget and report in a holistic way that maximizes colleges' time and resources.
- Enabling institutions to evaluate, learn and evolve to better support student success.
- Activating the Vision for Success core commitments and achieving the Vision goals.

This tool is a demonstration version of the prototype structure which was tested and improved over three years of piloting with nine colleges. Access to the Vision-Aligned Reporting—DEMO page is being provided to individuals in the California Community Colleges system during the 2023-2024 academic year for training and information purposes.
