Institution-Set Standards

- Student Achievement Data
 - Course completion rate
 - Program Completion number (degrees+certificates)
 - Degree completion number
 - Certificate completion number
 - Transfer to 4-yr institutions
 - Licensure exam pass rates
 - Job placement rates for CTE program completers
- College to set standards based on data and discussion

What is a standard?

- ACCJC
 - “...identified level of performance determined by the institution to be acceptable.”
 - “measure will be assessed for reasonableness and effectiveness by peer external evaluators”
- Different from benchmark or goal
- College should annually meet and easily exceed—
at minimum
- Implications of not meeting standards may
require action plan to get back “up” to standard

Foothill Approach

 - Most recent term/year (Fall 2014 or 2013-14)
 - Longitudinal (2009-10 to 2012-13, 2011-12 to 2013-14)
 - Disaggregation (ethnicity, program)
