Yes, the PT Academic Counselor and PT Staff were hired towards the end of Fall 2023.

We have met the Chancellor's Office guidelines by hiring the necessary minimum personnel, a PT school certifying official staff, and a PT Academic Counselor. We are working closely with ETS, Clockwork, institutional research to refine the data collection process by evaluating the outcomes accuracy, and enhance outreach process.

7. Explain your implementation timeline and if there have been any changes or updates.

The Veterans Resource Center action plan was to hold 2 student success events per quarter, which the VRC has not complete for the past 2 quarters. Increase service rates by 40% by Spring 2024 is still in progress, and increasing number of scholarship applicants and the number of African American students scholarship applicants by Winter 2024, pending the end of Winter guarter, March 25, 2024, in progress.

8. Explain the evidence the program used to evaluate progress and provide an update on progress.

The Veterans Resource Center uses evidence provided by the following data systems: CCCO Data Mart, Clockworks, and Argos data reports. Each reporting tool is used in various ways to compare the number of students that are currently signed up with VRC and students that are not. We would also look at the services that are being used and the success rates of the students as they complete each quarter.

According to the Disproportionate Impact dataset, it identifies black and male veteran groups that experienced disproportionate impact in 2022-2023. The percentage point gap for black veteran students is -30 and the number additional successes needed to erase the percentage gap is 36. The percentage point gap for male veteran students is -4 and the number of additional successes needed to erase the percentage gap is 3.
