"Based on all available data, there appears to be an "undersupply" of Digital Photography workers compared to the demand for this cluster of occupations in the Bay region and in the Silicon Valley sub-region (Santa Clara county). There is a projected annual gap of about 681 students in the Bay region and 146 students in the Silicon Valley Sub-Region." Since submitting the program review, the Photography department met with members of the Institutional Research team for clarification on the data. IR reviewed the data on the back end and confirmed that although the list of CTE courses listed in the note section was not accurate, all CTE courses were properly coded as CTE and were included in the data that was pulled. It was also noted, that although the 13.5 CTE unit benchmark might be typical for allied health students it is not necessarily typical for photography students and that is OK.

The photo department identified the need for Guided Pathways to help students complete the CTE courses.
