Productivity: Need additional context on "the program faculty are no longer..." Does the unit load for clinical course need to be adjusted? Are there specific courses that require more load than assigned? We applied the program for being aware of how cohort size can affect productivity and the action plan for student retention.

FTES: We appreciate the explanation about the cohort program and the enrollment over a two year period which explained the drop in 2023. We recognize the number of students admitted may not be within the control of the program due to the number of clinical sites. It is important for the college to recognize the need to support the program in clinical partnerships (clinical instructor meetings and end of year celebration).



Sections: We encourage continued conversation in collaboration with DMS. The program mentioned there are continuing education courses that has never been taught. More context would be appreciated since community education would be a possible growth opportunity for this program.
