From Spring 2010 to Spring 2011:

- Total WSCH – Resident and Non-Resident is up 3% at 166,107.
 - Total headcount is up 2% at 13,279.
 - Resident WSCH is flat at 141,811.
 - Non-Resident WSCH is up 21% at 24,296.
- Day student course enrollment is down 5% at 24,912, with a 4% decrease in WSCH at 129,036.
- Evening and weekend student enrollment is up 14% at 5,706, with a 7% increase in WSCH at 29,250.
- First-time and first-time transfer student headcount is down approximately 1% from 1699 to 1684.
- Continuing student headcount is up 1% from 9,875 to 10,390.
- Course enrollment numbers of students from the FHDA District service area (Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos and Saratoga) decreased 3% from 13,600 to 13,188 while course enrollment numbers from the East San Jose area (San Jose east of 880, Alviso, Milipitas, Fremont, Union City, Newark, Hayward and East Palo Alto) increased 9% from 7,244 to 7,874.

 - Distance Learning sections offered is up 13% from 193 to 219.
