- Online Learning
 - Total online learning estimated WSCH is down 5% at 37,882.
 - Online learning headcount is up 2% from 5,270 to 5,396.
 - Online learning enrollment is up 4% from 7,691 to 7,978.
 - Online learning sections offered is up 7% from 211 to 226.

- International Students
 - F1 and FZ students are up 11% from 1,005 in Winter 2012 to 1,117 in Winter 2013.
 - Male students represent 57% of F1 and FZ in Winter 2013, an increase of 5% from Winter 2012.
 - The top countries of origin continue to be China (267), Hong Kong (252) and Indonesia (131).

- Zip Code Grouping
 - Enrollment from all zip code groups declined from Winter 2012 to Winter 2013 except those from All Other Areas (+7%) and from San Jose East of 880, Alviso, Milpitas, Fremont, Union City, Newark, Hayward and East Palo Alto (0%).
 - The largest percentage of decrease in the number of students enrolled from Winter 2012 to Winter 2013 were those from Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos and Saratoga at -13% (4,015 to 3,475).
 - The largest increase in the number of students enrolled from Winter 2012 to Winter 2013 was those from All Other Areas from 3,559 to 3,792.

- As a percentage of the total population, there was a 3-percentage point decrease from Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos, and Saratoga (31% to 28%) and a 3-percentage point increase from All Other Areas (28% to 31%).
- As a percentage of the total population, there was a 1-percentage point increase in enrollment from San Jose East of 880, Alviso, Milpitas, Fremont, Union City, Newark, Hayward and East Palo Alto (23% to 24%).
- All other zip code groupings were relatively stable in terms of enrollment as a percentage of the Winter 2012 and Winter 2013.
