

## Foothill College Spring 2013 and Spring 2014 Census Enrollment Comparisons Report

From Spring 2013 to Spring 2014:

- Enrollment
  - Resident and non-resident estimated WSCH is down 2% at 141,667.
  - Total headcount is down 4% at 11,911.
  - Resident estimated WSCH is down 4% at 115,664.
  - Non-resident estimated WSCH is up 5% at 26,002.

- Online Learning
  - Total online learning estimated WSCH is up 14% at 43,422.
  - Online learning headcount is up 12% from 5,486 to 6,144.
  - Online learning enrollment is up 12% from 8,225 to 9,188.
  - Online learning sections offered is up 16% from 234 to 271.

- Zip Code Grouping
  - Enrollment from all zip code groups declined from Spring 2013 to Spring 2014 except those from “San Mateo, Atherton, Redwood City, San Carlos and Foster City” (+4%) and “All Other Areas” (+8%).
  - The largest percentage of decrease in the number of students enrolled from Spring 2013 to Spring 2014 were those from “Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos and Saratoga” at -10% (4,254 to 3,847).
  - The largest increase in the number of students enrolled from last spring to this spring was those from All Other Areas from 2,105 to 2,275.

- As a percentage of the total population, there was a 2-percentage point decrease from “Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos and Saratoga” (34% to 32%) and a 2-percentage point increase from “All Other Areas” (17% to 19%). All other zip code groupings remained flat.

- Student Population
  - The largest increase in headcount (2,378 to 2,477) and estimated FTES (+15) occurred among returning students.
  - Enrollment among continuing students demonstrated the largest decline in both headcount (-5%) and estimated FTES (-3%) from Spring 2013 and Spring 2014.

- Student Ethnicity
  - Headcount from all ethnicities between Spring 2013 and Spring 2014 declined or remained flat except among those who decline to state their ethnicity (+120) or Filipino (+66).
  - As a percentage of the total population, the largest decline by ethnicity is among Whites, from 35% in Spring 2013 to 33% in Spring 2014.

- International Students (F1)
  - Enrollment among F1 students increased from Spring 2013 to Spring 2014 by 5%, from 1,181 to 1,245.
  - Females represented 44% of all international students (F1 and FZ visa status) in Spring 2013 compared to 39% in Spring 2014.
  - In Spring 2013 and Spring 2014, the top three countries of origin for international students included China (S13: 306 vs. S14: 362), Hong Kong (S13: 249 vs. S14: 191) and Indonesia (S13: 149 vs. S14: 171).
  
- Applicants who Registered in Spring 2014
  - About one-quarter of the applicants reported that they were never involved in activities that served their community in the past year (24%).
  - Over half of the applicants reported that their family income over the past year was \$50,000 or less (53%).
  - At least half of the applicants reported that they spoke another language other than English at home (51%). The top three languages included Spanish, Chinese, and Vietnamese.
  
- Day/Evening Status
  - Course sections offered during the day decreased by 11% from 707 to 626.
  - Course sections offered in the evening decreased by 10% from 164 to 148.
  - Course sections offered on the weekend decreased by 23% from 64 to 49.
  - Course sections offered online increased by 16% from 234 to 271.

- Out-of-State Non-Resident Online
  - There are 33 non-residents who are enrolled in online courses and have an out-of-state address. The largest representation of these students resides in Washington (12%).
  - Out of these 33 students, there are 8 non-residents who are enrolled in online and not online courses and have an out-of-state address. They live in Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Hawaii (2), Idaho, New Hampshire and Nevada.
