RE: Part-time faculty count

Overview

Part-time faculty with an instructional assignment between 2010-11 and 2012-13 were identified to determine the unduplicated headcount for this employee category. Table 1 shows the number of part-time faculty have remained relatively consistent over the past three years, between 400-450 employees. The percentage of part-time faculty increased by 6% from 2010-11 to 2012-13 (428 to 453). There was an 8% increase during the same time period in the number of part-time faculty teaching on the main campus and a 2% increase among those teaching face-to-face or hybrid.
