SUGGESTIONS FOR IMPROVEMENT:

PRC suggests incorporation of the SA-SLO data analysis and reflection into the actual program review narrative, not just TracDat.

PRC suggest additional discussion around student equity and the role of the unit in relation to the college's overall student equity efforts.

PRC suggests the unit determine specific focus areas for improvement.
